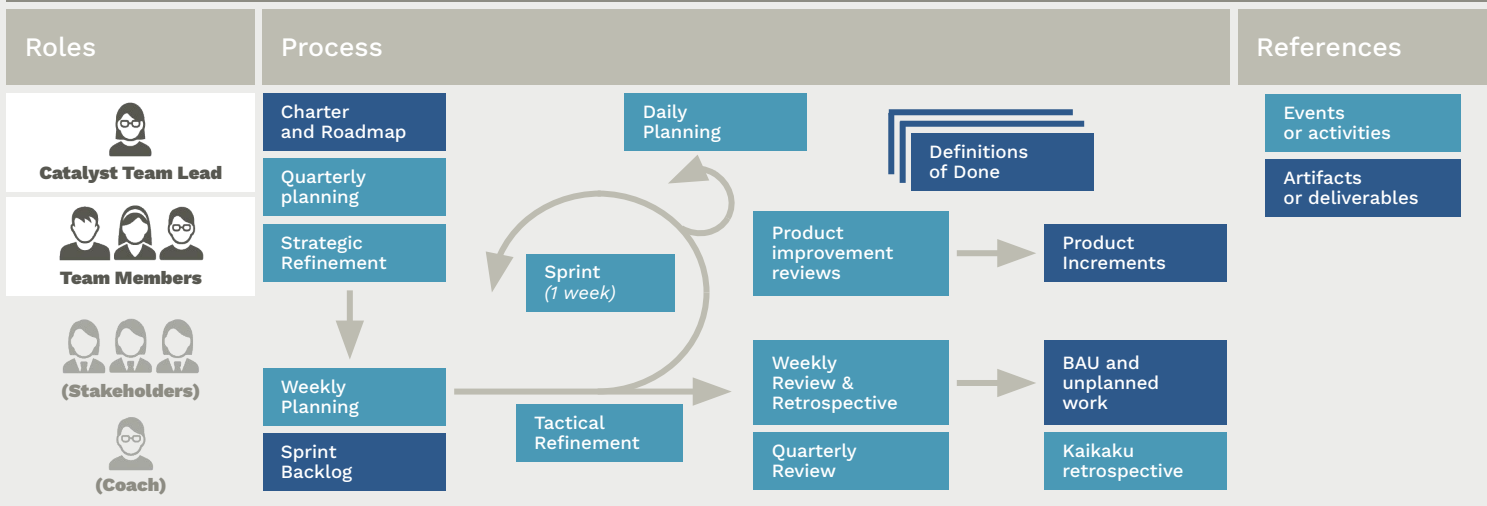


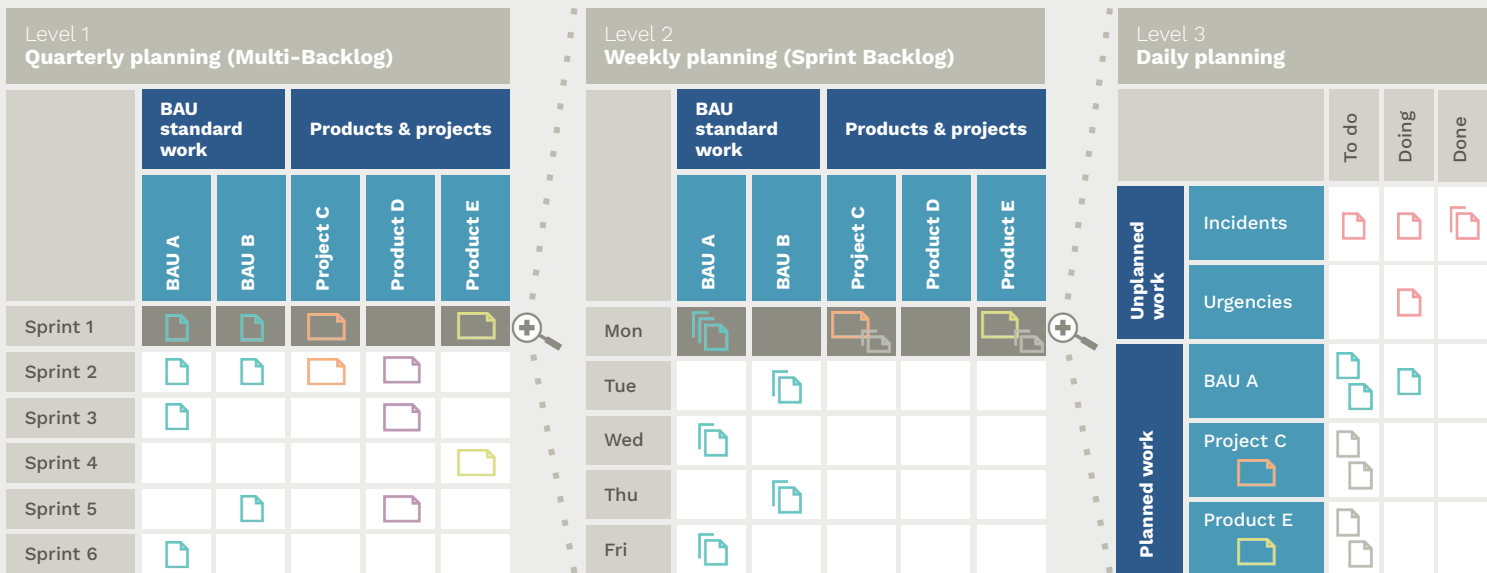
The alternative to Scrum and Kanban for bringing agility to business teams.

Vima is an agile framework designed to maximize the productivity and adaptability of business teams that have to deal with a chaotic mix of work types such as repetitive tasks, deadlines, multiple dependencies, constant interruptions, contributions to various projects and products, etc. If Scrum and Kanban don't feel like a good fit for your team, don't force it... try Vima!

Key differences with Scrum

- Vima teams run a “business” service (instead of doing Product Development or innovation work). This can be internal or external customer facing.
- Vima teams have a Catalyst Team Leader (instead of a Product Owner and Scrum Master) and typically several co-existing value streams or work types.
- Vima teams use a Team Charter and a Multi-Backlog to visualize, prioritize and plan their work (instead of a single Product Backlog and Product Goal)
- Vima backlogs and taskboards integrate a calendar format to deal with date constrained work. Vima sprints are one week.
- Vima teams can have multiple co-existing instances of various meetings and artifacts based on the value streams and working agreements of the team.
